- Submitter is the legal rights holder of the book being submitted (text or image) and the book's content does not contravene Canadian legislation.
- Author agrees that we will purchase one copy of their book through our vendor.
 Do not bring a physical copy of your book to the Library when submitting this application.

By submitting a copy of my book to the Port Moody Public Library I understand that:

- If accepted, the book will be included in the White Pines Collection for a one-year term.
- If the book goes missing or is damaged, the Port Moody Public Library will purchase a replacement copy for the Collection.
